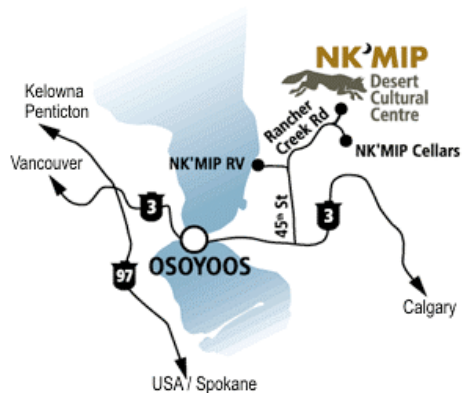
If you're a golfer arrive early to play 18 holes at the traditionally styled par 72 Osoyoos Golf & Country Club.

### From Vancouver & area:

Take Hwy. 1 East (The Trans-Canada) to Hope, then follow Hwy. 3 East to Osoyoos.

### From Calgary and area:

Take Hwy. 1 West (The Trans-Canada) to Sicamous, and follow Hwy. 97A South to Vernon passing through Kelowna, Penticton and continue south on Hwy. 97 until you reach Osoyoos.

### From the USA:

After crossing the border, drive north on Hwy. 97 for approximately 3 miles to Osoyoos.
