Laminate Floor

Cleaning and Maintenance:

For everyday cleaning, vacuum the floor to remove dirt and debris. It is recommended to occasionally mop the floor using a cotton string mop and a minimal amount of water. Use a mixture of soap-free household cleaner (either vinegar or ammonia work well) and water for a more thorough cleaning. Wipe away stains with a damp cloth. Stains caused by inks or paints may require a cloth moistened with acetone (nail polish remover). Apply felt protectors on the bottom of furniture and floor mats to preserve the beauty and appearance of the floors.

NOTE:

CAUTION:

Abrasive cleaners and scouring pads can scratch and damage the flooring. Never wax, sand or apply lacquer to laminate flooring.
